**MEN'S BASKETBALL PLAYER WAIVER, RELEASE OF LIABILITY,
INDEMNIFICATION, AND CODE OF CONDUCT FORM**

The undersigned states and agrees as follows:

- 1.) The undersigned agrees that player voluntarily participates in playing basketball and assumes all risks associated with such play.
- 2.) The undersigned acknowledges that there are risks and hazards in playing basketball including, but not limited to, those caused by court conditions, playing conditions, equipment and other participants, in addition to the acts of dribbling, passing, shooting, and dunking a basketball, running, jumping, stretching, sliding, diving and collisions with other players, spectators, or stationary objects, any of which may cause serious injury to the player.
- 3.) In consideration of the City of Thibodaux allowing play on the courts owned, operated, or used by the City of Thibodaux, I AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS AND RELEASE the City of Thibodaux Recreation Department and their officials, employees, agents and assigns from any and all claims, demands, lawsuits, costs and attorney fees arising out of playing in the City's program listed above.
This Release and Indemnification shall be effective and bind any and all heirs, dependents, executors, and assigns.
- 4.) I acknowledge that I have read the foregoing instrument and understand its terms and agree to abide by its terms and conditions.

CODE OF CONDUCT

This Code of Conduct applies to everyone – parents, players, coaches, sponsors, and spectators, who participate in any activity sponsored by, or in any way associated with the Recreation Department of the City of Thibodaux.

1. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are permitted on the City of Thibodaux premises (buildings, playgrounds, parking lots) at any time.
2. All information furnished by parents, players, coaches, or sponsors must be true. False information and/or forged/altered document, is prohibited.
3. All participants, players, parents, coaches, sponsors and spectators will, at all times, behave in a polite and sportsmanlike manner. Only a coach may question a decision of an official. Abusive language, cursing, profanity, threats or ridicule are prohibited.
4. No one shall hit another person before, during or after a Recreation Department activity.
5. No one shall deliberately damage Recreation Department and/or Thibodaux Civic Center property.
6. If any of the above rules are violated, you may be terminated from any and all other programs and escorted out by City of Thibodaux Police Department.
7. No gum allowed on the courts.
8. No outside Basketballs allowed inside the building.

2019 ADULT BASKETBALL (SPRING LEAGUE)

Adult Basketball will be under the jurisdiction of the Thibodaux Recreation Department. TREC will establish leagues and playing schedules for the program. The Adult Basketball League Director will administer the various leagues.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY:

1. A player will be ineligible to play during the 2019 season if the individual is:
 - a. under 18 years of age
 - b. Has NOT completed High School
 - c. a college basketball red-shirt
 - d. less than 1 year removed from any involvement in college or professional sports.
2. A player is eligible to participate on only one team at a time.
A player cannot switch to another team. Once dropped from a team, said player cannot be reactivated by the same team.
3. All players must have their name on a team roster sheet in order to be eligible. The use of an individual player not listed on the team roster constitutes an automatic forfeit upon a written protest by the opposing team by 4:00 P.M. of the day following the game in question.
4. An entry fee in the amount of \$150.00 must be turned in to the Thibodaux Recreation Department's office with your team registration starting Monday, Feb 4, 2019 between the hours of 8:00 A.M.-NOON and 1:00 P.M.-4:00 P.M. and until **Noon on MARCH 8, 2019**. To be eligible for any closing tournament, a player's name must appear on his team's roster and must participate in at least five (5) regular season games.

Team using players not on their roster shall automatically forfeit any game in which said players participate. The manager who allows a player not on his roster to participate, and the player who knowingly plays illegally, will be suspended immediately and indefinitely. The length of the suspension and date of reinstatement shall be based upon the recommendation of the League Director.

TEAM ROSTERS:

1. All league teams will be limited to 12 players, including a player coach.
2. The roster is due prior to the first game and must include name, address, and birth date, along with phone number and signature of each player. Players will not be considered eligible until all information is received by the Thibodaux Recreation Department. Teams will be required to forfeit any game in which an ineligible player participates.
3. Changes in rosters may be made by filling out a Team Roster Revision Form, which can be obtained from the League Director. **THE TEAM ROSTER REVISION FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND TURNED IN TO THE LEAGUE DIRECTOR PRIOR TO GAME TIME ON THE DAY OF YOUR SCHEDULED GAME.** Players are not eligible for play until a Team Roster Revision Form is completed and received by the League Director prior to scheduled game time, as stated above.

PLAYING RULES:

All games will be played according to the **LHSAA Rules**, except to local provisions stated herein.

1. Teams are responsible for paying the Referees. The cost will be \$25.00 per game per team. The games will not start until the Referees are paid (**NO EXCEPTIONS**). A team who forfeits or does not attend a game is still responsible to pay. **Referees will decide if they will let a “pick-up” game take the place of a forfeited game.**
2. League teams must have standard uniforms, consisting of numbered jerseys. All jerseys the same color. No two players on any team may wear the same number. Absolutely no street clothes allowed. If knee braces are worn, braces must be padded.
3. Halves will be 18 minutes running time, except final minute of first half and final two minutes of game, with two-minute halftime.
4. Overtime period shall be two minutes. After one such period has been played and if the game remains tied, a sudden death overtime will be played. The first team to score wins.
5. A team must begin to play with five (5) players. A team may end with no less than Three (3) players.

6. Teams must be ready to begin play at the scheduled starting time. There will be no waiting period to get a sufficient number of players to begin play. A team will forfeit if it is not ready to play at the scheduled starting time.
7. Forfeiture of game may be made in accordance with the rules of forfeiture or if a team does not have a sufficient number of players to begin play. A team will forfeit if it is not ready to play at the scheduled starting time. Each team will still be responsible to pay officials even if a game is forfeited.
8. A team forfeiting three (3) games during the season will be dropped from the program, resulting in the loss of entry fee.
9. The official will grant at least five (5) minutes to warm up prior to beginning play in the event a game is delayed by an earlier overtime game.
10. When a technical foul is called on a player or the team bench, the two (2) team points will be awarded on the scoreboard. No free throws will be taken on technical fouls. Technical fouls will be awarded as a team foul and/or personal foul.
11. A bonus free throw is awarded for each common foul (except player control) beginning with a team's 7th personal foul during a half, provided the first attempt is successful. Beginning with a team's 10th personal foul during a half, the offended team receives two free throws.
12. Any player ejected from a game by a referee for any reason will be ineligible to play in his team's next game. If he is allowed to play in said game, it will be an automatic forfeit. If any player or non-playing coach is ejected from either his team's final game of the regular season, or any tournament game or receives a second ejection during the current season, he will receive a suspension that is deemed appropriate by the League Director. This suspension may range from one (1) game to forever.
13. Players will be allowed five (5) fouls per game.
14. A player that is ejected twice in a season will not be allowed to participate in any games following to those ejections.
15. **If a team is losing by 20 points or more in the second half, the clock will not stop in the final 2 MINTUES.**

PROFANITY:

No profanity of any kind is allowed before, during or after a game. A two point technical foul will be awarded on the scoreboard. In other words, profanity has no place in this type of program.

PLAYER CONDUCT:

1. Any player, coach or manager who physically strikes or in any way harms or causes harm to a League Director, a game official, scorer, timekeeper or a participant, either on the playing area or in the vicinity of the playing area, or before, during or after a game, will be removed from further participation in this program. Depending on the seriousness of the offense, the Thibodaux Recreation Department Director may remove the player and/or the team from the program for the remainder of the season, or for one calendar year, or forever.
2. Any unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, managers or teams will be dealt with accordingly.
3. All program participants are adults and are expected to behave as adults at all times. Do not jeopardize either your own or you team's future in the program by your behavior.
4. The Thibodaux Recreation Department Director may take any action he deems necessary in order to insure proper conduct of anyone who chooses to participate in this program.

PROTESTED GAMES:

There will be **NO** protest allowed on a judgment call by the officials. The only protests that will be looked into will be the eligibility of a player or a rule application. The burden of proof is the responsibility of the protesting team.

A written protest must be submitted to the Thibodaux Recreation Department by 4:00 P.M. the day following the protested game.

The Thibodaux Recreation Director and the League Director will rule on all protests and disciplinary problems encountered in the program. There will be no appeal of their decision.
