"The most rewarding part of my job is when people show their appreciation in helping solve their problems or issues."

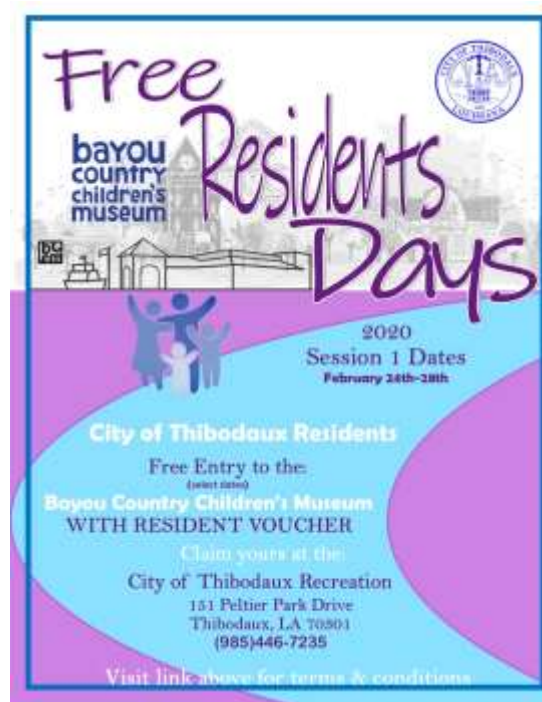
Congratulations
