Bradley has worked for the City of Thibodaux for 17 years. When he is not at work, Bradley enjoys spending time with his family and fishing. For those who do not know Bradley, he grew up in Bourg and moved to Thibodaux when he attended Nicholls State University.

Typical tasks performed by Bradley as well as the other detectives include fingerprinting, fingerprint analysis, DNA collection, photography, warrant preparation, report writing, etc. As a supervisor, Bradley has additional tasks to perform, such as keeping supplies stocked, proof reading reports, case management, etc. Bradley recalls his biggest achievement to date being his recent 70lb weight loss and dedication to restoring a healthy lifestyle.

When asked to comment what is most rewarding about his job while working for the City of Thibodaux and his proudest moment, Bradley said,

*"The most worthwhile and rewarding part of my job is having the opportunity to take the worst of the worst off of the streets just not in the typical high adrenaline chases and dramatic takedowns. Once I was thanked by a man for saving his life by encouraging him to stay awake and fight. Even though I'm sure the medical treatment he received had much more to do with his survival, this always stuck with me."*

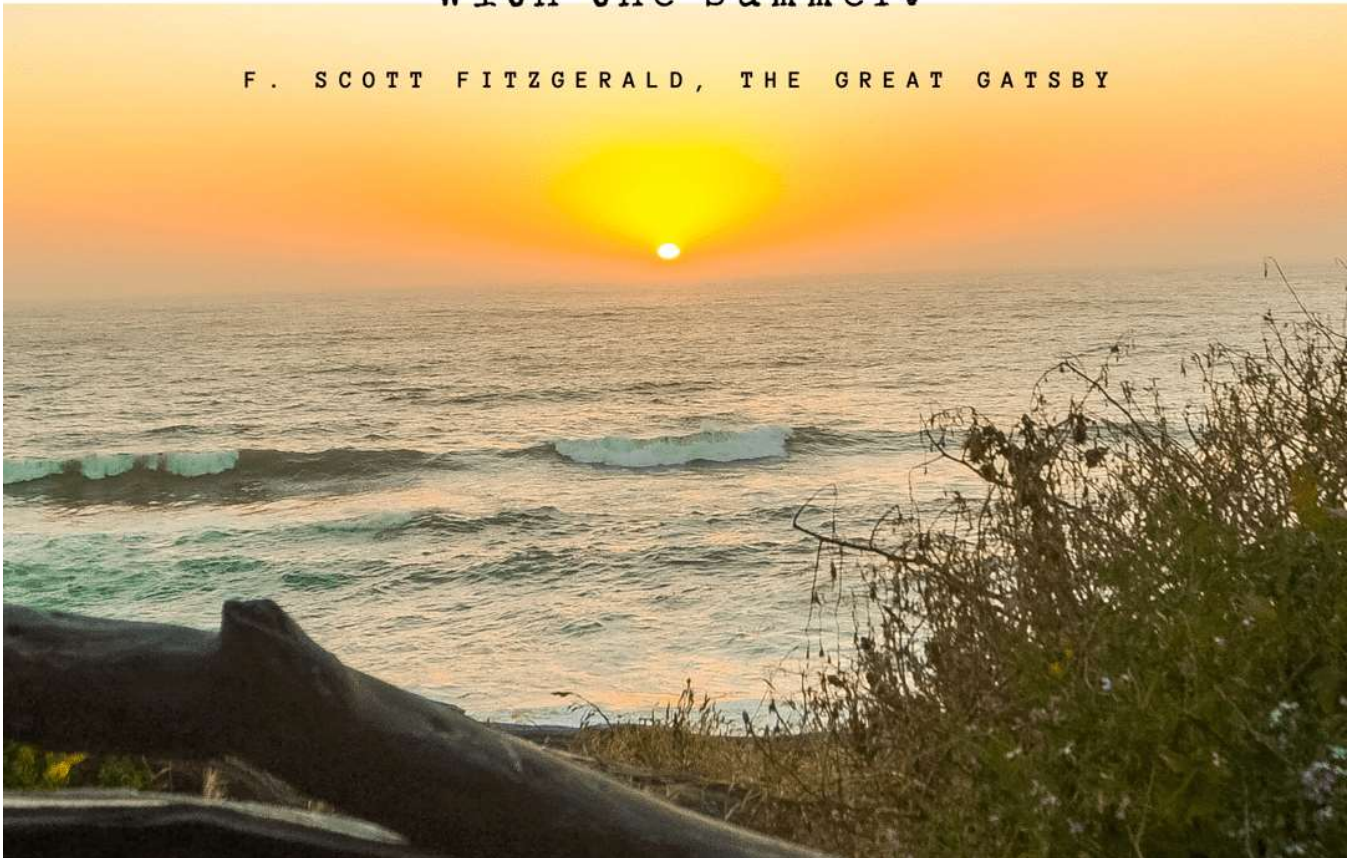
