Warrants Issued For Suspect Involved In Vehicle Pursuit

Thibodaux Chief of Police Bryan Zeringue announced that an arrest warrant has been obtained through Thibodaux City Court for Daronti Wesley (B/M, 19 of Thibodaux, La.), for Aggravated Flight From An Officer (Felony), Driver Must Be Licensed and No Seat Belt.

On Thursday, April 11th, 2019, shortly after 8:00 p.m., Thibodaux Police Department Officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop on a 2003, gold Nisan Altima for a seatbelt violation. After failing to stop and leading Officers on a brief vehicle pursuit, the driver who was later identified as Daronti Wesley stopped the vehicle near the intersection of E. 7th Street & Bayou Lane, where he bailed out on foot. Officers gave chase, but eventually lost sight of Mr. Wesley. The vehicle was secured and a perimeter was set up in an attempt to locate Mr. Wesley. The vehicle was also occupied by Oranekia Londo (passenger) who was detained at the scene. Although Mr. Wesley was not located during the search, an arrest warrant was obtained for him by the City Court Judge and the Bond was set at \$25,500.00. At no time, did police observe Mr. Wesley or Ms. Londo to be in possession of any weapons.
