



## Pedestrian Crossing At Canal Boulevard Bridge

In January, the city received Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development's (DOTD) review and comments of the engineering plans for the (Canal Blvd. Bridge) Pedestrian Walkway and Enhancement project. The Project Engineer, Al Badeaux, is currently working on several requests from DOTD for the final plan review. The project includes a 5 ft. cantilevered walkway on the upper side of the bayou, enhancement of the bridge railings, and the addition of vintage style light fixtures on the bridges. The city anticipates the project to be under construction by mid summer. "We look forward to the successful completion of this project in partnership with DOTD and the Lorio Foundation. The project impact is going to add a safe walkway for residents that cross Bayou Lafourche on foot or bicycle as well as make the area more attractive, which is one of the most visible and highly traveled areas within the community," said Mayor Caillouet.
