

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDED COOPERATIVE ENDEAVOR AGREEMENT WITH THE HOUMA POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2020 VOCAL GRANT TASK FORCE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, the Thibodaux Police Department wishes to cooperate with the Houma police Department for the purpose of establishing a Crime Victim Task Force and facilitating the application for funds available through the VOCAL Grant administered by the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and the Administration of Criminal Justice; and

WHEREAS, in order for the aforesaid agencies to apply for the VOCAL grant funds it is necessary to have a written agreement between the agencies forming the crime victim task force; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of this Amended Agreement shall be effective for the period January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 plus a period of ninety-days in order to conclude administrative reporting requirements, with the city receiving \$16,250.00 in overtime pay reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish the crime victim task force, and the responsibilities of both parties, it is necessary to execute a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Houma Police Department outlining the terms and purpose of the cooperative effort between the public agencies; and

WHEREAS, in order for the City to execute this proposed amended agreement it is necessary for the Council to authorize the Mayor to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an Amended Cooperative Endeavor Agreement with the Houma Police Department under the conditions mentioned hereinabove.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of the said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby made a part hereof.
