**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A
LANDOWNER AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT WITH ENTERGY
LOUISIANA, LLC FOR USE OF CITY PROPERTY TO PERFORM
WORK AT THE ST. PATRICK STREET SUBSTATION**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, Entergy is in the process of studying the location of the existing substation on St. Patrick Street, and has requested that they be allowed to enter onto City property in the area for the purpose of conducting various studies and surveys; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to execute a Landowner Authorization Agreement with Entergy Louisiana, LLC in order to allow Entergy to enter onto City property to conduct soil borings, environmental assessments, engineering design and soil analysis, and clearing, trimming and/or removal of trees limbs or other vegetation; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the execution of the Landowner Authorization Agreement by the adoption of an appropriate ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux that the City does hereby authorize the Mayor to execute a Landowner Authorization Agreement with Entergy Louisiana, LLC for the use of City property to perform work at the St. Patrick Street Substation.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of the right-of-way agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and thereby made a part hereof.
