

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND RE-ENACT SECTION 21-43 OF
THE THIBODAUX CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES - WATER RATES

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that Section 21-43 of the Thibodaux City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Sec. 21-43. *Water rates.*

The following monthly water rates shall be imposed on the residents of the city effective January 1, 2027:

\$6.28	<i>Minimum charge 1,000 gallons or less.</i>
\$6.21/1,000 gallons	<i>1,001 – 15,000 gallons</i>
\$6.16/1,000 gallons	<i>15,001 – 50,000 gallons</i>
\$6.09/1,000 gallons	<i>50,001 – 100,000 gallons</i>
\$6.03/1,000 gallons	<i>Over 100,001gallons</i>

This rate may be adjusted annually in an amount not to exceed the U.S. City Average Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for All Items, Not Seasonally Adjusted, for the previous 12 months as published by the U.S. Department of Labor. The annual rate adjustment shall be approved by the City Council by means of the adoption of an appropriate ordinance prior to implementation.
