The lease agreement is for an initial term of five years for a monthly rent in the amount of \$1,200.00. The lease will automatically renew for four additional five year extension terms. The monthly rent will increase 10% from the previous term amount in year one of each extension term.

In accordance with the provisions of Article V, Section 2 (A) (e) of the Thibodaux City Charter, the City Council must adopt an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to execute the new lease.
