

**OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL
CITY OF THIBODAUX
CITY HALL
THIBODAUX, LOUISIANA
APRIL 21, 2026**

The City Council of the City of Thibodaux assembled in regular session at its regular meeting place, City Hall, 310 West 2nd Street, Thibodaux, Louisiana, on Tuesday, April 21, 2026 at 5:00 P.M.

There were present: Councilman Harang, Taylor, and Naquin

There were also present: Mayor Kevin Clement and Beau Brooks

Absent: Councilwoman Crochet and Councilman Mire

Mayor Clement presented proclamations recognizing the achievements of the Biddy Basketball Boys 10U and 12U teams for winning their respective World Championship titles.

On motion of Councilman Harang, seconded by Councilman Taylor, the Council voted to approve the minutes of the April 7, 2026 City Council Meeting as written. Upon roll call the vote was as follows:

In accordance with the prescribed statewide agreed-upon procedures by the Legislative Auditor, the Finance Director has submitted the monthly revenue and expense report for March 2026 to the City Council for review.

Councilman Harang introduced an ordinance to adopting the General Alimony, Streets, Roads & Alleys, Fire Department, and Fire Protection Facilities “Adjusted” Millage Rates in the City of Thibodaux for the 2026 Tax Year. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 5, 2026.

Item No. 2 was removed from the agenda. The City Council Administrator explained that Council approval was not required for this type of property division pursuant to City of Thibodaux Code of Ordinances, Section 18-56.

Councilman Naquin introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Article IX, Section 901 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance- Signs-Purpose. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Taylor introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Article IX, Section 904 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance – Prohibited Signs. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Harang introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Article IX, Section 905 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance – Nonconforming Signs. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Naquin introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Article IX, Section 906 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance – Exempt On-Sight Signs. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Harang introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Article IX, Section 904 (E) and (F) of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance – Sign Standards-On Premises. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Taylor introduced a zoning ordinance to amend and re-enact Section 505, Table 5.1 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance – Residential District Permitted Uses and Special Exceptions – “Office” – Special Exception in R-2 Zoning District. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Taylor introduced a zoning ordinance approving a Special Exception request in accordance with Section 307 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance in order to allow a Personal Services Establishment in an R-3 Zoning District – 509 Gerald T. Peltier Drive (Barbershop). The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Harang introduced a zoning ordinance approving a Special Exception request in accordance with Section 307 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance in order to allow a Retail Goods Establishment in a B-1 Zoning District – 817 Jackson Street (Card Shop). The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Harang introduced a zoning ordinance to amend the Official Zoning map in accordance with Section 104 of the Thibodaux zoning Ordinance to change the zoning classification for a tract of property from the R-3 District to a C-1 District – 506 St. Phillips Street. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

Councilman Naquin introduced a zoning ordinance to amend the Official Zoning map in accordance with Section 104 of the Thibodaux Zoning Ordinance to change the zoning classification for a tract of property from the R-1 District to an OS District- Levert Land Company on Rosedown Drive. The public hearing for this ordinance will be held on May 19, 2026.

The Mayor informed the Council of issues and projects going on throughout the City:

- **City of Thibodaux removed 3 pipes from the Rienzi**
- **Tetreau Overlay project is going well**
- **East side drainage project just finished phase 1 where 31 structures and 121 pipes were assessed and they identified no major defects**
- **Miracle Field is coming along well with June 11th being the anticipated completion date**
- **Eagle Park resurfacing is complete**
- **Summer Programs are filling up fast**
- **Eagle Dr street lights are about 90% complete**
- **Clean-up Saturday was on 4/18 and volunteers went around and picked up trash in the city.**
- **USI Insurance provided the City’s dividend check for workers compensation for \$148,000**
- **Fireman’s Fair will be April 30th-May 3rd**

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 5:27 P.M.
