A RESOLUTION NOTIFYING THE LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY THAT THE CITY OF THIBODAUX HAS REVIEWED THE MUNICIPAL WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT REPORT FOR LA0032948-SOUTH THIBODAUX WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AND SET FORTH THE REQUIRED ACTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux in regular session assembled, that:

WHEREAS, the City of Thibodaux Department of Wastewater has reviewed the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention (MWPP) Environmental Audit Report for LPDES Permit Number LA 0032948 AI Number 19012; and,

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality MWPP Environmental Audit Program is designed to encourage municipal wastewater facilities to provide compliance maintenance prior to becoming noncompliant; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City Council to approve the Environmental Audit, by adoption of an appropriate resolution, prior to submission to the LA Department of Environmental Quality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Thibodaux that the city does hereby notify the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality that the City of Thibodaux Department of Wastewater has reviewed the Municipal Water Pollution Prevention Environmental Audit Report (Audit Period: January 2025 - December 2025) and sets forth the following action necessary to maintain permit requirements contained in the South WWTP's LPDES Permit:

The City of Thibodaux is committed to resolving the specific issues identified in the audit via the following actions:

- 1. Address Aging Infrastructure (Part 3: 50 Points)** The facility is currently 33 years old, generating the maximum 50 points for age
 - Action:** The City will continue its proactive maintenance utilizing third-party contracts and will proceed with the replacement or rehabilitation of critical components as identified in the Capital Improvement Plan.
- 2. Mitigate Fecal Coliform Exceedances (Part 2, Section D)** The Audit noted exceedances for Weekly and Monthly Geometric Mean Fecal Coliform.
- 3. Financial Planning** The City will continue to utilize available government grants to fund these major capital improvements, supplementing current user-charge revenues.
