HELP YOUR NEIGHBOR PROGRAM

The Help Your Neighbor Program is a utility assistance program for eligible senior and disabled citizens. The program was developed by the City in an effort to assist persons living on a fixed income to pay their Water, Sewer, Gas and Garbage bills. To qualify for the program, applicants must:

- Reside within the corporate city limits of Thibodaux and be at least 60 years old or disabled/handicapped.
- The individual or household income shall not exceed the current US Poverty Income Guidelines
- Complete an application through the Lafourche Council on Aging

Qualified individuals and/or households may receive two payments of up to \$ 100.00 each per year to pay for City utilities.
