

Deborah's proudest moments working for the City of Thibodaux involved working as a team, such as participating in Relay for Life, the haunted house, and special projects.



City of Thibodaux - Emergency Preparedness

The City of Thibodaux just completed construction of a new Emergency Operations Center (EOC). The intent was to develop a facility that serves as a multi-use complex that enhances the City of Thibodaux's ability to conduct governmental operations in support of the residents, businesses and organizations in our community. It is located in the Warren J. Harang Jr. Auditorium and will form the hub of the City response to daily activities as well as emergencies. The communications capability affords the City of Thibodaux the ability to maintain contact with local, parish, state and federal partners during all types of events.

Jacques Thibodeaux, the City of Thibodaux Emergency Preparedness Director is excited about the new center. "I would like to thank the Mayor, the City Council and all of the City employees who helped make this happen. Having a multi-use center in a hardened building, with a large generator for backup power, also with redundant communications and the ability to operate safely is huge. This center gives us another tool in emergency management. It modernizes our approach to emergencies and will benefit the City tremendously."

The EOC will also serve as an executive conference center, as well as a training room and video recording studio for all of the various City departments. Mayor Tommy Eschete had some thoughts on the center. "We are always evolving in the City of Thibodaux. We identified a need for this center in 2020 due to eight hurricanes, extensive rain events and the COVID response. This center gives us the capability that we did not have before. The versatility of this center is impressive and we will use it to the full extent. We will have the capability to link all of our departments to the center in several communications platforms. It will serve as a great resource to all departments."


