Emergency Preparedness

In July 2021, the City of Thibodaux completed construction on a brand new, state of the art Emergency Operations Center (EOC). Little did we know, we would put the EOC into action three weeks later in response to Hurricane Ida. The EOC gives the City of Thibodaux the capability to integrate with Parish, State and Federal agencies. Mayor Tommy Eschete made the comment shortly after the storm "Our new EOC was a game changer that gave us the chance to showcase what we could do as a team! It served as the nerve center for the entire response and now for the recovery."


