Khalil and Tyren have worked for the City of Thibodaux for 6 years and Lennie and Terrence have worked for the City of Thibodaux for 7 years. Currently, Khalil is a student athlete at Louisiana College playing football and studying Business Administration; also, Tyren is a student athlete at Louisiana Christian University playing football. Terrence graduated from Northwestern University in 2019 with a Bachelors Degree in Communications. Lennie is a coach at E.D. White Catholic High School.

On a typical day as a baseball supervisor can involve the following: supervise baseball operations, schedule baseball workers, baseball setup and pick-up, umpire, as well as encourage and empower kids.

# PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF THIBODAUX SECTION 8 RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM Opening of Waitlist

The City of Thibodaux will accept applications for the Housing Choice Voucher (Section 8) Program Waitlist. This program is a federally funded program which supplements the rental payment of extremely low and very low income families. The program is funded by HUD.

Once on the waitlist, the following preferences will be given: Extremely Low Income and Elderly or Disabled.

Applicants residing outside of the City of Thibodaux will be required to lease a unit within our jurisdiction for one year before using portability unless otherwise approved.

In order to ensure everyone's safety in light of possible COVID-19 restrictions, a <u>call in procedure **ONLY**</u> will be utilized. 150 applications will be accepted. YOU CAN NOT APPLY IN PERSON. APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AS FOLLOWS:


