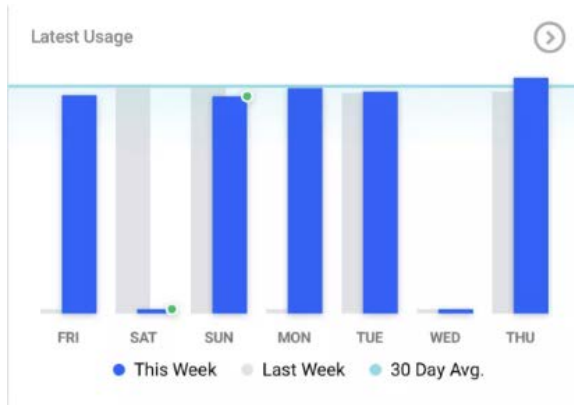

Eye On Water

Press Release

The Eye On Water App is organized into three sections: Overview, Account, and Usage. The Overview page will display any leaks detected and latest usage. The latest usage section displays the current week, previous week, or 30 day average of water usage. Green dots indicate lower usage than the previous week on that day. By tapping the arrow in the upper right corner allows users to jump to the Usage page of the App. The Account page allows users to view the utility company name and account details. Also, the resident's account location is displayed on a map along with the meter ID number. The Usage page provides a calendar, graphs, and savings calculator view of the resident's usage history. Tapping the graph option will allow residents to see a graphical representation of water use for a day, week, month, and year. The current selection remains blue while other bars of the graph are gray and remain visible to allow comparison of usage. To compare usage on different days, weeks, months, or years, swipe and keep touching the screen. The vertical scale of the graph changes when you stop touching the screen. The calendar section of the Usage page shows usage trends as a "heat map" in which light blue dots indicate less use and darker blue dots indicate more use. The Usage Key can be accessed by tapping the *i* button. To see more detail for any given month or day, tap the blue dot.

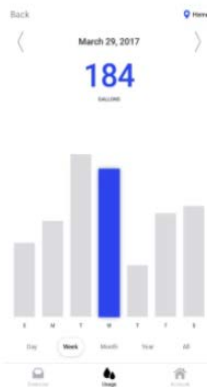
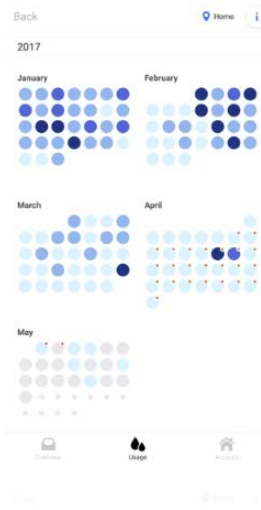
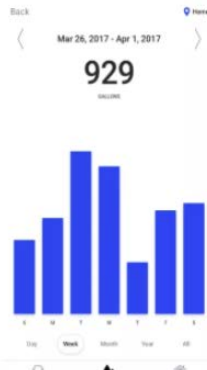
