
Come Play Pétanque in Peltier Park



Pétanque is a game that originated in the south of France in the early 1900's. It is played with metal balls, called boules. The object of the game is to throw your boules close to a target ball, called the jack. What started as a social game in a small French town steadily grew in popularity throughout France and around the world.

There is an avid group of *pétanquers* here in Thibodaux who play regularly in Peltier Park on Saturday mornings and Wednesday afternoon. The game of pétanque is suitable for everyone; it requires no special physical ability or skill. For many, it is simply a leisure social activity – a
